These events are ticketed with limited numbers. They are both fully catered and we are licenced for wine and beer, and Coffee!

The cost for the next event: Rock 'n Roll is \$25 which covers the music and a commemorative glass filled with wine. There will be 2 bands: Triple Beat and The Ring Ins who will play from 11am to 4pm.. dancing is encouraged.

We request that you do not bring your own drinks and food as everything is available here. The food is good quality and we try to offer good value. The food will be based as much as possible on local produce and please advise us of any dietary requirements.

We provide undercover seating with tables for sun protection and in case of inclement weather. The Granite Belt is cooler and less humid than the coast but we do have the occasional hot day so please bring a hat and a jacket.

We have always run a bus at around \$10 per person return from Stanthorpe and surrounds and will also run one from Ballandean if we have sufficient numbers. The bus must be booked with us but you can choose to leave your car here and take the bus on the return trip, or we will book a taxi for you.
